


MEDITATION OF THE DAY Strengthened by the Spirit of Love

outpouring of strengths, of wisdom and fortitude and understanding, etc. Our human love is weak; but divine love is power itself, since it is the very root of being. Confirmation signifies the dwelling of the Spirit of love in the spirit of a person. He will not be alone to face the world, but rather infused with strength from God—not the phony strength of worldliness or of brutality, but the strength of that unconquerable faith that filled the saints.

The idea that virtue should spring out of the Holy Spirit may be understood by analogy to human love. We find that when two people fall in love, their personalities frequently change. A person, previously very smart in the sense of worldly shrewdness, through wonder at the reality of love will become smart in the sense of being gifted with understanding. A hard, ambitious person may become one characterized by fidelity to love and the spirit of sacrifice. Just as these qualities flow out of the inner experience of human love, so do the gifts of the Holy Spirit flow from the inner bond of love the Spirit brings. Real Christian love is so much stronger than any attempt to become virtuous simply through idealism, because the Spirit of love becomes ours in a much more intimate way through the sacraments....

If the idea of the Holy Spirit is still vague to you, think of it in terms of the irrepressible yearning within you to be saved from a life fragmented by so many conflicting desires and fears, ambitions and frustrations. Or think of it as that flame which you detected in some ardent priest or sister or lay person who conveyed to you something of Christianity that you can never succeed in forgetting. —RONDA CHERVIN

Mayo es el mes de la devoción a María la Santísima Madre, que se originó en Roma en el siglo XVIII para contrarrestar la inmoralidad y la infidelidad entre los estudiantes de una universidad allí. Hacia fines del siglo XVIII, un celoso sacerdote jesuita, el Padre Lalomia, inició entre los alumnos del colegio romano de su Sociedad, la práctica de dedicar el mes de mayo a la Virgen. La devoción, que otros habían promovido en pequeña medida, pronto se extendió a otros colegios jesuitas ya toda la iglesia latina y desde entonces ha sido un rasgo habitual de la vida católica. Esta devoción ahora se ha extendido por la mayor parte de la Iglesia latina. Debido a que la festividad norteamericana del Día de la Madre cae en mayo, los católicos aprovechan este tiempo para recordar y tratar de emular el papel de María como madre. Por lo tanto, la devoción a María en el mes de mayo se centra tanto en María como modelo a seguir para las madres cristianas, como en la eterna castidad y pureza de María, y su fidelidad a la voluntad de Dios.

MARÍA: NUESTRA MODELO EN LA VIDA ORDINARIA

"No podemos olvidar que María pasó casi todos los días de su vida como millones de otras mujeres que cuidan de sus familias, crían a sus hijos y cuidan sus casas. María santifica las cosas ordinarias y cotidianas, lo que algunas la gente considera erróneamente como sin importancia e insignificante: el trabajo cotidiano, el cuidado de los más allegados, las visitas a amigos y familiares. Qué bendita cotidianidad, que puede estar tan llena de amor de Dios". Ofrezcamos hoy a nuestra Madre: Afectuosos detalles de servicio y atención a los más allegados".


Oración para esta semana: a la Madre del Señor por todas las Madres

May is the month of devotion to Mary the Blessed Mother, which originated in Rome in the 18th century to counter immorality and infidelity among students at a college there. Toward the end of the 18th century a zealous Jesuit priest, Father Lalomia started,

among the students of the Roman college of his Society, the practice of dedicating May to Our Lady. The devotion, which others had promoted in a small way, soon spread to other Jesuit Colleges and to the entire Latin church and since that time it has been a regular feature of Catholic life. This devotion has now spread through most of the Latin Church. Because the North American holiday of Mother's Day falls in May, Catholics take this time to recall and try to emulate Mary's role as mother. Therefore devotion to Mary in the month of May focuses both on Mary as a role model for Christian mothers, and Mary's ever lasting chastity and purity, and her fidelity to God's will.

MARY: OUR MODEL IN ORDINARY LIFE

"We can't forget that Mary spent nearly every day of her life just like millions of other women who look after their families, bring up their children, and take care of their houses. Mary sanctifies the ordinary, everyday things -- what some people wrongly regard as unimportant and insignificant: everyday work, looking after those closest to you, visits to friends and relatives. What a blessed ordinariness, that can be so full of love of God." Let us offer to our Mother today: Affectionate details of service and attention to those closest to us."
