Scholarships are made available and will be awarded to graduating high school seniors that are parishioners of St. Thomas More Parish and who will be attending an accredited institute of higher learning. The scholarship is to assist in the payment of school costs.

- 1. The number and amount of the scholarships granted each year shall be determined by the Knights of Columbus Council #7773 in developing the Council's yearly operational budget.
 - a. Depending on the amount budgeted by the Council, the scholarships could be in the following amounts: \$1,000; \$500; \$200.
 - b. Based on the recommendation of the Scholarship Committee:
 If only one (1) applicant is received or approved, the Committee may at their discretion, award any of the amounts that have been approved by the Council.
 If only two (2) applications are received and approved by the Committee, they may at their discretion, award any two of the amounts approved by the Council.
 - c. In the event no applications are received from graduating seniors, then former recipients and other college level students, meeting all the requirements may apply.
 - d. Winner(s) will be notified when the selection(s) is made and the money will be awarded upon proof of acceptance to a school of higher learning.

Acceptable schools of higher learning shall include:

Four Year College or University; Jr. College or Accredited Technical Schools

2. Eligibility:

- a. Applicants must be a son, daughter, stepchild, grandchild, step grandchild of a registered Parishioner of St. Thomas More Church in good standing.
- b. Must be an active Catholic.
- c. Must have a financial need.
- d. Be of high moral character and integrity.
- e. Shown abilities of leadership in parish activities.
- f. Demonstrated scholastic ability.
- g. Have an accumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher. Applicants with less than a 3.0 GPA will not be considered.
- h. Complete and submit application packet no later than the last day of May.
